**MEASURE W
 SENIOR CITIZEN TAX EXEMPTION APPLICATION**

Applications must be filed annually between May 15 and June 15. In accordance with the provisions of the resolution adopting and imposing this Tax, failure to file between May 15 and June 15 will automatically invalidate the Tax exemption for that tax year. No exceptions can be granted to the closing date.

This application is for a senior citizen tax exemption with respect to the special tax (the "Tax") imposed on Measure W by the Governing Board of the Davis Joint Unified School District (the "District") pursuant to Resolution No. 02-09. The application is made with respect to:

2. The property owner and/or eligible spouse must submit with this application a copy of a birth certificate, driver's license, or other official document showing date of birth. To be eligible for the reduction in the Tax, the property owner or eligible spouse must be at least 65 years of age by July 1, 2009
3. The property owner must also provide evidence of ownership of the dwelling unit. Such evidence may consist of a copy of the county tax bill for the property, a copy of a title report or title policy issued in the last year, a copy of a recorded deed, or other official document acceptable to the

District. If the property owner is claiming the reduction in Tax through a spouse who is not an owner of the property, the property owner and spouse hereto certify that the dwelling unit is their primary residence.

4. Each property owner certifies that he/she understands that: (a) the application is for an exemption in the Tax; and (b) for the exemption to continue beyond one year, an application must be filed annually between May 15 and June 15 to obtain the exemption for the Tax year.
5. Each property owner certifies that the dwelling unit is the primary residence of the property owner.
6. I/we certify that this is the only application exemption in the Tax that I/we have filed for the 2009/2010 Tax year.
7. If there is more than one property owner, each such owner must sign this application. If the exemption is being claimed through a spouse who is not a property owner, the spouse must sign this application.
8. This application may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which shall constitute both one and the same application.

I/we declare under penalty of perjury, under the laws of the State of California, that the foregoing and the documentary evidence submitted herewith are true and correct.
