Design planning is now under way for a new Willett Elementary multipurpose room (MPR), which is tentatively scheduled to be completed by Summer 2022. The new multipurpose facility will include an open space to accommodate assembly seating for the entire school (up to 650 students). This new and improved space will include stage, music room, warming kitchen, staff, student and all gender restrooms and as well as utility infrastructure improvements. The building design will be identical for the César Chávez, Birch Lane, and North Davis Elementary Schools.
