Dear Neighbor,

Design planning is now under way for a new Birch Lane Elementary multipurpose room (MPR), which is tentatively scheduled to be completed by Summer 2022. The new multipurpose facility will include open space to accommodate assembly seating for the entire school (up to 650 students). This new and improved space will include a stage, music room, warming kitchen, staff, student and all-gender restrooms, as well as utility infrastructure improvements. The building design will be identical to that designed for César Chávez, North Davis, and Willett Elementary Schools.
