



## DJUSD Bond Project at Your Neighborhood School

Dear Neighbor,

On June 20, 2019, the DJUSD Board of Education passed the [Call to Climate Action Resolution](#) supporting the District's commitment to environmental education, sustainability and the continuing expansion of District-wide efforts to improve the energy efficiency of DJUSD schools.

On February 6, 2020, the Board of Education entered into a partnership with ARC Alternatives to help DJUSD develop a Solar Master Plan. One of the primary goals in the Solar Master Plan is to offset 80% of the District's energy use through photovoltaic energy production (with solar panel arrays on most DJUSD campuses), a goal which exceeds CalGreen and Title 24 State requirements. The installation of photovoltaic solar panels is a key step in our effort to expand renewable energy sources in DJUSD and at your neighborhood school site.
