

New District Meal Charge Policy, Effective January 1, 2018

The Department of Student Nutrition Services (SNS) works to ensure all Davis Joint Unified students have access to the meals they need to be successful in school. Research has proven that students who are hungry have a difficult time in class. It is our policy to treat every student with respect, regardless of their ability to pay and SNS will provide service to every student who requests a meal.

Effective January 1, 2018, the DJUSD offers a full meal to all students in grades TK-12, notwithstanding their ability to pay for the meal or if whether they carry a negative balance on their meal account. This charge policy applies only to full meals. Students may not charge à la carte items.

Meal accounts can be prepaid using credit or debit cards by creating an account with My School Bucks Visit www.myschoolbucks.com.

As a reminder: Free and Reduced Price Meals are available to families who believe they may qualify you can now apply online or by downloading a copy of the application and turning it in to DJUSD Student Nutrition Services.
