Debra DeSpain- Kaiser will not release until 2024 rates released; Sutter Health Plus and Western Health received; declined Blue Shield, Health Net, Aetna, CIGNA, United Healthcare. JPA/Trust-received CCCSIG, waiting on SISC, CVT, San Mateo Medical Consortium.
