## **Review of Active Employee Western Health Advantage**

No updated cost from WHA because they will not rate us, plan design only. Can get illustrative rates but not firm rates if we want that.

No vote on plans, wait for new rates with slightly different options to change plan costs.

Explanation on how rates are deducted from paychecks- how it changes in December for the new insurance year.

Explanation of the DJUSD 2024 CalPERS rate handout. Annual cost divided by 12 less the district contribution is what the employee pays. This will be different for non-12 month employees as they pay annual rates but in spread over only their work year/days. The document will have the 10 and 11 month rates.

### **Review of Sutter Health Plan Options**
