

# ELO-P and Davis Kids Klub FAQ

2023-2024

**\*\*Update October 2023\*\***

## 1. What is ELO-P?

ELO-P stands for “Expanded Learning Opportunity Program.” State law defines expanded learning programs or ELO-P as” before school, after school, summer, or intersession learning that focus on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on, engaging learning experiences.”

## 2. What is Davis Joint Unified School District offering to fulfill their ELO-P requirement?

DJUSD is partnering with local non-profit, Davis Kids Klub and offering after school childcare and enrichment. Davis Kids Klub is offered from the end of your students’ school day until 5:55pm each school day.

## 3. How do I sign up?

## 4. I’m on the waitlist for DKK. How does the waitlist work? Is it first come, first serve?

All waitlists are being managed by the ELO-P staff at DJUSD. Students are enrolled from a waitlist when space/facilities and staffing are available. Per the ELO-P guidelines, it is required that a 20:1 ratio is maintained for students in grades 1-6 and a ratio of 10:1 is maintained for students in grades TK and Kindergarten. Per the ELO-P Program Plan guide, DKK waitlists are NOT first come, first serve. Our waitlists prioritizes students who are considered “unduplicated pupils” - meaning, they may fit one of the following criteria: homeless, foster youth, qualify for free or reduced lunch, and an English learner.

## 6. Are there fee waivers for Davis Kids Klub? How do I qualify for a fee waiver?

Please note\* a free/reduced lunch form must be filled out each year to qualify\*

- B. Foster Youth  
C. Homeless  
D. English Learner

**7. I think my student might qualify as an English Learner, but I am not sure if they qualify for a fee-waiver.**

Students who list a home language/primary language as a language other than English when they enroll in DJUSD will be given the ELPAC test to assess their English proficiency.

- If a student tests as “**I-FEP**” they are considered “Initial fluent English proficient” and are not considered an English learner and do not qualify for a fee-waiver.
- If a student tests as “**R-FEP**” they are considered “reclassified Fluent English proficient” and are no longer considered an English learner and do not qualify for a fee-waiver.
